Simple Number Meanings

Introduction:

Several years ago I learned how to give Lo Shu Numerology readings and since then I've noticed how many times numbers pop up while doing magic or mentalism. Numbers that are basically just throw-away moments.

"Choose a number between 1 and 10..." And then you deal down that many cards.

Instead of just dealing the cards, you could make the number the person chose appear more meaningful...

"Interesting that you chose the number seven, as that number means spirituality. It tells me you're the kind of person who searches for deeper meanings in the things around you, instead of just taking everything at face value."

And then you continue with the trick.

This can work for more than just single digit numbers if you add the digits together until you end up with a single digit. For example:

Number given: 67

Add $6 + 7 = 13$

Add $1 + 3 = 4$

You'd actually distill that number down aloud as part of the routine:

"6 plus 7 = 13, and if we add the 1 and 3 together we get down to the number 4, which means security. That tells me you're the kind of person who makes sure things are orderly. If someone needs something done right, they can count on you to do it."

If the idea of giving readings during a routine is new to you, give it a try. You're not trying to be a psychic, or extra mysterious. You're not telling fortunes. You're just making a "nothing" moment in a routine mean something, at least to that person.

What To Say For Each Number

When they choose a number from 1-9, you can give them a “mini reading” based on the number meaning from Lo Shu Numerology. You don’t have to memorize every meaning below — if you become familiar with them you can just kind of “wing it” during a performance.

One: Interesting, that’s the number that signifies beginnings. Because you chose that number I know when something needs to get done you’re not afraid to jump in and get started. Other people notice and appreciate that about you.

Two: Interesting, that’s the number that signifies cooperation. Because you chose that number I know even though you have strong beliefs, your willingness to be open-minded and fair draws people to you.

Three: Interesting, that’s the number that signifies expansion. Because you chose that number I know even if you don’t go looking for new experiences, when they come upon you you’re able to take what’s good from those and use it for growth.

Four: Interesting, that’s the number that signifies security. Because you chose that number I know people can depend on you — you’re seen as someone who’s solid as a rock to others and they appreciate that.

Five: Interesting, that’s the number that signifies activity. Because you chose that number I know you are always on the go. At times that may seem overwhelming, but you’re at your best when your plate is full.

Six: Interesting, that’s the number that signifies communication. Because you chose that number I know your desire to understand things comes in handy when the people around you ask for advice. They know they can come to you and you’re eager to pass on the knowledge you have.

Seven: Interesting, that’s the number that signifies spirituality. Because you chose that number I know you have a continuous search for knowledge, a desire to find the hidden truths that others may not even know exist.

Eight: Interesting, that’s the number that signifies inspiration. Because you chose that number I know that while some people get bored easily, you have the ability to come up with ideas and thoughts that create excitement and happiness in your life.

Nine: Interesting, that’s the number that signifies change. Because you chose that number I know while some people get all stressed out with change in their lives, you have ways to cope with that, and even welcome change at times in your life. You don’t see change as a bad thing.
